All students must attend at least one Mandated Test Prep seminar. We strongly recommend participation in the Test Prep session. There is no charge for these sessions. Completion of all SBL and SDL courses is recommended before taking the SDL assessment. Whenever possible, we encourage all students to take **Parts One and Two of each assessment on different days.**

A minimum enrollment of 10 students is required for the sessions to be offered. The Test Prep sessions will include: highlights of relevant coursework concepts. Use the SBL and SDL New York State Certification Examinations Preparation Guides in constructing narrative responses to content specific issues. You can only attend Test Prep after attending Internship Orientation.

To actively participate in the course or independently engage in self study students need to download and bring to test prep sessions the SBL/SDL NYSTCE Preparation Guides (www.nystce.nesinc.com).
